

## Updating ClearSight Networks Gigabit Adapter SC1 Driver

Before Installing ClearSight Analyzer 3.2 onto a ClearSight Analyzer Gigabit system, check the ClearSight Gigabit driver to ensure it is current. The current ClearSight Gigabit driver number is: 1.5.8.4 dated 1/16/2004.

If the ClearSight Gigabit driver needs to be updated please perform the following steps:

- 1) Shutdown ClearSight Analyzer
- 2) Download the ClearSight Gigabit driver from:  
<http://www.clearsightnet.com/files/software/cs-gbd.zip>
- 3) Extract the contents of the .zip file to C:\Program Files\ClearSight\driver\gigabit. If the folder has not been created, click Yes to create the folder during the extraction process.
- 4) Open the Adapter Properties window for the ClearSight Networks Gigabit Adapter SC1 (**Start > Control Panel > System > Hardware tab > Device Manager > Double Click on the ClearSight Networks Gigabit Adapter SC1**).
- 5) Select the Driver tab
- 6) Click on the Update Driver button
- 7) Select the "Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)" setting and click on the Next button
- 8) Select the "Don't search. I will choose the driver to install." Settings and click on the Next button
- 9) Click on the Have Disk button
- 10) In the directory field enter: C:\Program Files\ClearSight\driver\gigabit
- 11) Click on the OK button
- 12) Highlight the ClearSight Networks Gigabit Adapter SC1 and click on the Next button
- 13) If the warning box for driver compatibility is displayed click on the Continue Anyway button
- 14) When the driver has been installed click on the Finish button
- 15) Click the Close button to close the ClearSight Network Gigabit Adapter SC1 properties window
- 16) Reboot the computer
